

ABOUT THE HUMAN'S IN THE TELLING

November 2020 marks two significant anniversaries. Seventy-five years since the opening of the Nuremberg War Crimes Trials, and seventy since the signing of the European Convention on Human Rights. These events are linked by David Maxwell Fyfe, whose lifelong commitment to natural law led him to become British prosecutor at Nuremberg and one of two artisans of the Convention.

To commemorate, a new generation of David Maxwell Fyfe's family, are sharing the story of his journey from Nuremberg to Strasbourg through Sue Casson's song cycle, Dreams of Peace & Freedom. Performing the piece and bringing the story alive through their social media storytelling, they are bridging the generational divide to tell a forgotten piece of history across multi-media platforms.
